Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer
What will happen during the workshop?	The workshop lasts approximately 55 minutes. After the introduction, participants will be given headsets to listen to the Lilly and the Wave Audio Story. Then, we will invite you to reflect on the story with the materials provided.
What is the Lilly and the Wave Tour?	Lilly and the Wave Tour is a creative arts community project that invites families across England to reflect upon hope and transformation. The tour offers creative workshops based on the immersive audio story, Lilly and the Wave and will travel to 20 cities during summer 24.
Can I leave my child to attend the workshop alone?	Unfortunately not. This activity is designed for parents/guardians and their children to experience together.
Can I bring an infant or younger child too?	As space is limited, we ask that only participating family members attend the workshop. Ideally, we would like you and your 6+ child to fully experience the activity, and younger children should not be left unattended.
Will pictures be taken? Will the session be recorded?	Yes. Recordings (audio or video) from the workshop may be used to create a documentary about the tour or incorporated into the final exhibition. However, it's your choice to be included or not. We will provide a consent form at at the start.
Will I be able to take the artwork home with me?	You can take a picture but the artwork produced during the workshop will be joined with other artwork from other workshops across England to create a giant wave sculpture, representing unity and hope.
What if I can't make it?	Spaces are limited. We understand that things come up. If you are not able to make it, please let us know so that we can offer your spot to another family.
What happens if I need to leave in the middle of the workshop?	If for any reason you can not stay the whole length of the activity, no worries. You are free to leave at any time.
How many tickets should I book?	Please reserve one ticket per person in your group (including children). One adult + One child = 2 tickets.

Why do I need to provide my telephone number?	If you provide us with your phone number, we will send you a reminder about the event via text. Lilly and the Wave is a community project, and does not have any commercial interests. We will not share your number with any third parties or send you unwanted messages.
Can I attend more than one workshop?	Yes! We would love for you to join Lilly as she travels across the UK. If there are available spaces, you are more than welcome to attend.
Will food & drink be served?	Water will be available. We would love to chat over tea, but as the workshops are very short, there is not enough time to enjoy food or drink. Please keep in mind the activities will likely take place in a food-free space in the library.
Is this event insured? Is there an insurance for this event	Yes, there is public liability insurance coverage for this event.
Is there an age requirement?	This workshop is for children from 6 years old and their parents or guardians. Participants may use scissors, glue and other crafts materials and should be able to do so independently.
